PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish the procedure Department of Corrections’ (DOC) staff shall follow when considering whether it would be appropriate to send an inmate out of state, or receive an inmate from another jurisdiction, for placement under an Interstate Corrections Compact (ICC) or an Intergovernmental agreement (IGA).

PHILOSOPHY

It is the philosophy of the DOC to use codified criteria and procedures for identifying inmates for ICC or IGA placement, which promotes consistency throughout the process. DOC also believes that the use of an ICC or IGA placement may be beneficial to inmates in identified cases.

AUTHORITY

28 V.S.A. §§ 1601 – 1610, 28 V.S.A. § 1621

POLICY

Vermont may assign inmates to an ICC or IGA placement, or receive inmates from another jurisdiction, under an ICC or IGA. The DOC shall establish criteria to be considered when determining whether to consider an inmate for supervision in another state through an ICC or IGA. The DOC shall also determine criteria for the consideration of receiving an inmate from another jurisdiction for placement in Vermont.
