Sentenced Statuses:

-Sentenced: convicted of crime(s) -Sentenced/Detained: convicted of crime(s) and held pre-trial for other crime(s) -Sentenced W/Hold: convicted of crime(s) and held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction -Sentenced/Detained W/Hold: (rare) convicted of crime(s), held pre-trial for other crime(s), and held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction

Detained Statuses:

-Detained: awaiting conviction for crime(s) -Detained W/Hold: awaiting conviction for crime(s) and held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction

Hold Status:

Hold: being held for US Marshals or other jurisdiction

NOTE: Individuals in each booking status are considered in the custody of the Commissioner of Corrections. The Commissioner has authority to make release decisions for incarcerated individuals with a "sentenced only" booking status consistent with the law and when taking public safety into consideration. All other booking statuses require action by another authority (e.g. the court) to release a person from incarceration.

Crime Types

Incarcerated individuals are classified into different Crime Types based on the most serious crime for which they are sentenced, detained, or held. For example, 01:Fel./Serious. The number (e.g., 01) indicates the severity of the crime ranked from 01-11 from most severe to least severe. Next, the Crime Type displays whether the most serious crime was a felony (Fel.) or misdemeanor (Misd.). Finally, the category of crime is provided (e.g., Serious). See below for examples of each Crime Type. Each individual is counted once in the crime type data.

Gender Data:

In this report, gender data are categorized as follows: -Cisgender Female: Sex female, identifies female ("Female") -Cisgender Male: Sex male, identifies male ("Male") -Transgender Female: Sex male, identifies female ("Transgender") -Transgender Male: Sex female, identifies male ("Transgender") -Intersex: A term referring to people who have physical markers that differ from the medical definitions of male or female ("Intersex") -Other: Individuals who do not identify with any of the above gender categories ("Other")

NOTE: Transgender Female, Transgender Male, Intersex and Other were combined into one category: "Transgender & Other" for this report due to low numbers of individuals who identify with these genders. 




Incarcerated Population by Race | N=1378




